### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act increasing the minimum pension for public retirees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 32 is hereby amended by striking out section 90C<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, as so appearing, and

2 inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 90C1/2. A state employee or member of the state teachers' retirement system who has been retired under the provisions of this chapter or similar provision of earlier law on a superannuation, accidental disability or ordinary disability retirement allowance and who has completed at least 20 years of creditable service shall have his retirement allowance increased to an amount not to exceed \$24,000; provided, however, that such allowance shall be subject to the provisions of paragraph (e) of section 102.
