The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act prohibiting hate speech.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 20. (a) As used in this section, the term "hate speech" shall mean speech that
- 3 carries no meaning other than the expression of hatred for some group, such as a particular race,
- 4 color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, or disability, in
- 5 circumstances in which the communication is likely to or does provoke violence.
- 6 (b) Whoever makes or circulates hate speech or causes hate speech to be made or
- 7 circulated shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$500 or by imprisonment in a jail or house
- 8 of correction for not more than 1 year or by both such fine and imprisonment.
