Dear All,

Pursuant to Executive Office for Administration and Finance Bulletin 6, I write to provide notice that the Registry of Motor Vehicles Division of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (“RMV”) is proposing a one-time fee for non-resident short term registration. This fee is associated with the implementation of M.G.L. c. 90, § 2D, as amended by section 1 of Chapter 423 of the Acts of 2022.

The proposed fee will be \$20 per short-term registration, initially effective pursuant to emergency regulations 810 CMR 4.00, and permanent as of September 29, 2023. The estimated revenue to be raised from this fee is \$100,000 annually.
