An Act establishing the quarterly allocation of Chapter 90 funds for cities and towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 6C of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following section:-

3           Section 80. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, beginning June 1  
4 of any year, the department shall expend on a quarterly basis money to each city and town for  
5 projects: (i) approved under chapter 90 or any capital appropriation pursuant thereto; and (ii)  
6 related to the construction, maintenance or repair of roads and bridges. Such quarterly  
7 expenditure shall not exceed one-fourth of the total expenditure allotted to that city or town for  
8 the fiscal year pursuant to this section.

9           SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall promulgate or  
10 amend any regulations necessary to implement this act.
