Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8A of Chapter 239 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 3 Section 8A(a). As used in this section and in Chapter 239, the following words shall,
- 4 unless the context clearly requires otherwise, have the following meanings:
