## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Stephen Brophy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of Correction
- 2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Stephen Brophy, an employee of the Department. Any
- 3 employee of the Department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
- 4 days to the sick leave bank for use by Stephen Brophy. If Stephen Brophy terminates
- 5 employment with the Department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time
- 6 in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank
- days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
- 8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Department.
