## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act directing the city of Boston Police Department to waive the maximum age requirement for police officers for Alex Guzman.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the
2	provisions of Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive
3	the maximum age requirement for original appointment of police officers for Alex Guzman. If
4	Alex Guzman meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police Department, he shall
5	be eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer.
6	SECTION 2. The provisions of this act are severable and if any provision, or portion
7	thereof, should be held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent
8	jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions,
9	which remain in full force and effect.
10	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
