An Act relative to the transportation of marine vessels.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the maximum height and  
2 width dimensions as provided in sections 19 or 19A of chapter 90 shall not apply to any vessel  
3 being hauled from or back to a professional waterfront year round marine servicing business in  
4 the villages of Hyannis or Osterville and trucked by a professional licensed boat hauler on a  
5 public way within 3 miles of its waterfront location of origin in the town of Barnstable and  
6 which may pass over the roadways of the town of Yarmouth
