**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act directing the Bristol County Retirement Board to grant creditable service to Lucia M. Casey.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Bristol
2 County Retirement Board shall credit Lucia M. Casey, a member of the Bristol County
3 Retirement System, with creditable service for the period of January 1, 1981 to December 31,
4 1990, inclusive, for the purpose of determining her superannuation retirement allowance
5 pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws.
6 Before the date that any retirement allowance becomes effective in the case of Lucia M. Casey,
7 she shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the retirement system of the county in one (1) sum
8 or installments, upon such terms and conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to
9 that which would have been withheld as regular deductions from his regular compensation for
10 such previous service, plus interest.
