*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 258 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “Authority”, in line 48, the  
3   following words:- , any Law Enforcement Council established pursuant to section 4J of chapter  
4   40.
