An Act clarifying the prevailing wage law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 27D of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “works” in line 5, the following words:-  
3 and the inspection, testing and repair of fire protection systems in public building and public  
4 works.
