## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to railroad workers' earned sick time.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general rule to the contrary, any private railroad company or its
- 2 agents, contractors, subcontractors, vendors, sub-vendors, secondary vendors or subcarriers; and
- 3 the rail and transit division of the department of transportation, under contract to provide rail
- 4 service through the commonwealth, shall comply with the minimum earned sick leave standards
- 5 set forth within section 148c of chapter 149.
