**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to unemployment insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of Chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (a) by striking out in lines 3 and 4 the words
3 “Have been paid wages in the base period amounting to at least thirty times the weekly benefit
4 rate” and inserting in place thereof the following:-

5 "Have been paid wages in at least two quarters of the base period amounting to at least
6 thirty times the weekly benefit rate".
