An Act relative to fetal opioid drug exposure.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the
- 2 commissioner of the department of developmental services shall include fetal opiod drug
- 3 exposure and addiction under the definition of Closely Related Developmental Conditions as
- 4 defined under 115 CMR 2 and 115 CMR 6.06(1).
- 5 SECTION 2. The commissioner of the department of development services shall at their
- 6 discretion include additional diagnosis as part of the definition of closely related developmental
- 7 condition.
