#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act expanding the powers of the town of Brookline to delegate licensing authority.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 270 of the acts of 1985 is hereby amended by striking out section 5
- 2 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 Section 5. Notwithstanding chapters 138, 140 or 148 of the General Laws or any other
- 4 general or special law to the contrary, the town may, through its by-laws, delegate any licensing
- 5 authority.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
