In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)

An Act relative to regional municipal affordable housing trust funds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 55C by adding the
2 following subsection:-

3 (k) Notwithstanding section 53 or any other general or special law to the contrary, two or
4 more municipalities may form an inter-municipal agreement for the purpose of establishing a
5 Regional Municipal Affordable Housing Trust Fund. A participating city or town shall accept
6 this section and the inter-municipal agreement by majority votes of the municipal legislative
7 bodies under section 4 of chapter 4.
