An Act establishing appointed positions of district clerk and district treasurer for the Raynham center water district.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 222 of the Acts of 1947 as amended by Chapter 863 of
- 2 the Acts of 1977 is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following sentence:- "The board of water commissioners shall appoint a district clerk
- 4 and a district treasurer, who may be the same person and who need not be residents of the
- 5 district. The clerk and treasurer will serve for a term of 1 year and may be reappointed by the
- 6 commissioners to additional terms."
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the existing terms of a district clerk or district
- 8 treasurer elected before the effective date of this act. The board of water commissioners shall
- 9 appoint the successors to those positions when their current elected terms expire.
