**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to EMS leave without loss of pay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 111M of chapter 41, is hereby amended by striking every
2 occurrence of the phrase “city or town or fire or water district” and inserting in place thereof the
3 following phrase “city or town or political subdivision thereof, including the Boston Public
4 Health Commission, or fire or water district”.

5 SECTION 2. Section 111N of chapter 41, is hereby amended by striking every
6 occurrence of the phrase “city or town” and inserting in place thereof the following phrase “city
7 or town, including political subdivisions thereof, including the Boston Public Health
8 Commission, and fire or water districts”.
