In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to delivered food.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 270 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,

- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 27 the following section:-
- 3 "Section 28. No food delivery provider operating within the Commonwealth shall use
- 4 staples in order to seal bags or containers carrying raw or prepared foods or beverages."
- 5 SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon passage."
