An Act relative to culturally competent and effective health care.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be amended by

- 8 Health care facilities licensed under Section 51 of Chapter 111 of the Massachusetts
- 9 General Laws shall provide to both the Board of Registration in Medicine and the Center for
- Health Information and Analysis, the following data on a quarterly basis for physicians, medical

23	SECTION 2. The Center for Health Information and Analysis shall report on the data
24	collected under this section to the House and Senate Clerk and the Department of Public Health
25	no later than January 30th of each calendar year.
26	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective 90 days after enactment.
