Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 (h) Any public high school that operates hoisting equipment as part of a vocational
- 4 technical education program approved under chapter 74, shall be exempt from this section if the
- 5 school has met the requirements of clauses (i) and (ii) of subsection (e) and the supervising
- 6 instructor is on site at all times of operation and holds a license issued by the division of
- 7 occupational licensure under this section and is designated as the responsible person in charge of
- 8 hoisting equipment during that period of operation.
