In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to drug recognition experts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Nothwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the secretary of
- 2 the executive office of public safety and security shall develop a statewide standardization and
- 3 accreditation certification for municipal and state police officers to become drug recognition
- 4 experts for the purpose of providing testimony in court proceedings. The secretary shall submit
- 5 by December 31, 2024 any legislative recommendations to the clerks of the house and senate,
- 6 and the joint committee on public safety and homeland security.
