By Mr. Brady, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1614) of Michael D. Brady, Mathew J. Muratore and John F. Keenan for legislation to restore the retirement rights of certain employees. Public Service.

### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act restoring the retirement rights of certain employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (g) of subsection (2) of section three of
- 2 chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other special or general law to the contrary, any criminal
- 3 identification officer, first assistant criminal identification officer, or assistant criminal
- 4 identification officer employed by the Plymouth County Sheriff's Department's Bureau of
- 5 Investigation, who was classified as Group 4 under the Plymouth County Retirement System
- 6 prior to the transfer of said sheriff's department to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall
- 7 retain their Group 4 classification in the Massachusetts State Retirement System for the purposes
- 8 of said chapter thirty-two.
