An Act relative to survivor retirement benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, Chapter 32
- 2 Section 94B(2) of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition is hereby amended
- 3 by striking the word "five" in line 27 and inserting the word "ten" after the word "within" in line
- 4 27. Section 2. Chapter 32 Section 94B (2) of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014 Official
- 5 Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 31 after the word "compensation" the following
- 6 words," in the event that such person retires in accordance with this section any secondary cancer
- 7 shall be covered in accordance with section 9 of this chapter.
