Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 15LLLLLL the following section:-
- 3 Section 15MMMMMM. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
- 4 the month of January as Peace Officer History Month and recommend that the month be
- 5 observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
