An Act relative to the retirement of state university and community college police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 253, the words “University of  
3   Massachusetts police”

4           SECTION 2. Section 3 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
5   out the words “chief of security for the University of Massachusetts medical school or  
6   supervising identification agent”, in lines 327 through 328, and inserting in place thereof the  
7   following words:- “University of Massachusetts, state university and community college police.”
