An Act relative to defining employees in Group 2.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting in section 3 (g), in line 242, after the word “hospital,” the  
3 following new words:- “employees of the trial court of the Commonwealth who hold the position  
4 of court service coordinator, assistant court service coordinator, chief housing specialist, housing  
5 specialist, psychologist, court reporter, court interpreter, professional, clerical and other  
6 employees whose duty and responsibilities bring them in contact with criminal defendants and  
7 others whose court appearance is required.”
