## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to civil service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any existing law, including without
- 2 limitation any act or special act, the appropriate public authority for any city or town may revoke
- 3 the application of Mass General Laws Chapter 31 ("Civil Service") for a position or positions in
- 4 any classification that are filled on or after the effective date of the revocation; provided further
- 5 that the appropriate public authority shall provide to the Joint Committee on Public Service
- 6 documentation outlining the policy or policies that will replace the application of Chapter 31;
- 7 and provided further that said policy or policies shall include some level of preference being
- 8 given to military veterans. Appropriate public authority will mean, as applicable, the Select
- 9 Board, Mayor, City Manager or Chief Executive Officer of the City or Town.
- SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
