Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Official Edition is hereby amended by striking the word "and" before the words "the state lottery commission" and inserting after the word "commission" in line 32 the following words:- and committee for public counsel services.
