An Act relative to retirement benefits for municipal natural resource officers in Plymouth and Barnstable County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (g) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “wildlife and recreational  
3 vehicles”, the first time they appear, the following words:- “Municipal natural resource officers  
4 and supervisors employed by municipalities in Barnstable or Plymouth Counties having duties  
5 similar to law enforcement officers of the Department of Fisheries and Wildlife, “.
