**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to Boston school police retirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 3 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as amended by chapter 221 of the acts of 2018, is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the words “services having police powers;” the following words:- Boston school police
4 officers;.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
