An Act relative to the membership of the PRIM board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 201, after the words “representative of a public safety  
3 union” the following words:- from a list of 3 candidates nominated by the executive board of the  
4 Massachusetts Association of Contributory Retirement Systems, Inc. who shall be a member of  
5 the state employees’ retirement system, the teachers’ retirement system, or any other retirement  
6 system that has been vested in the PRIT Fund.
