## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to the retirement benefits of employees of the Cape Ann Transportation Authority.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) (b) of section four of
- 2 chapter thirty-two, or any other general or special law to the contrary, as of July 1, 2022
- 3 employees of the Cape Ann Transportation Authority shall be entitled to purchase creditable
- 4 service for periods of employment as provided in paragraph (1) (b), which purchase shall be
- 5 subject paragraph (2) (c) of section four of chapter thirty-two.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective upon its passage.
