**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to sales tax reduction to 5%.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking the words “6.25 per cent” and inserting in place thereof the words “5 per cent”.

3 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 64I of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
4 the words “6.25 per cent” and inserting in place thereof the words “5 per cent”.

5 SECTION 3. The act shall take effect on August 1, 2024.
