An Act relative to force sale of property by tax lien.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 37 of the chapter 60 as appearing in the 2020 official edition is hereby amended
2 by inserting at the end thereof the following:- "Any amount in excess of the amount owed to the
3 municipality for sale of property shall be remitted back to the former owner of the said property".
