In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to certain tax exemptions for non-profit educational institutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Clause (e) of paragraph Third of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- 3 Notwithstanding the foregoing, no more than ten parcels of property used as residences may be
- 4 exempt from property tax.
