**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act clarifying lobbying law violations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 45 of Chapter 3 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended

3 by striking clause(m)and inserting in place thereof the following:

4 “(m) The state secretary shall automatically disqualify a person convicted of a felony or
5 misdemeanor in violation of chapter 3, chapter 55 or chapter 268A or comparable offense under
6 federal law or the law of another state from registering as an executive or legislative agent for a
7 period of 10 years from the date of conviction”.
