In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to unpaid student loans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 13 of chapter 30A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- No board of registration operating pursuant to chapter 112 or agency shall deny issuance
- of, revoke or refuse to renew any professional or occupational certificate, registration, license or
- 6 authority of an individual based on an individual's default on an educational loan. This
- 7 paragraph shall not apply to the division of banks.
