An Act relative to fairness in public contracting.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the division of highways, as  
2 established by Section 37 of Chapter 6C of the General Laws, is hereby directed to amend its  
3 standard specifications, supplemental specifications, special provisions, and contract documents  
4 to provide for a minimum of 15 percent for overhead for work deemed to be additional work or  
5 extra work.
