An Act relative to the citizenship requirement to be appointed manger on license for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26 of Chapter 138 of General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “United States “in line 4 the
3 following words:-

4 “or a qualified alien under the federal Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. 1101”

5 And by inserting after the words “United States” in line 16 the following words:-

6 “or a qualified alien under the federal Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. 1101”
