**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to changing the name of the Salisbury Beach State Reservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The parcel or parcels of land and rights therein collectively known as Salisbury Beach
2 State Reservation shall hereinafter be known as “Robert 'Boots' Chouinard State Reservation at
3 Salisbury Beach”. The commissioner of conservation and recreation is authorized to cause to be
4 recorded in the proper registry of deeds such form as may be required by law to document said
5 name change.
