- 4 The department shall provide that for facilities generating useful thermal energy by using
- 5 eligible biomass technologies that also install an electrostatic precipitator or other emissions
- 6 control device, an alternative energy credit shall be earned for 1,706,000 British thermal units of
- 7 net useful thermal energy so as to improve air quality.
