An Act relative to regional tourism councils.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23A is hereby amended by adding the following new section:-
- 2 Section 69. Grants allocated to regional tourism councils through the Massachusetts
- 3 Tourism Trust Fund established in section 13T in chapter 23A shall be distributed not later than
- 4 September 1 of the fiscal year for which they are allocated.
