**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to Hot Box Detectors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 176 of Chapter 160 of the General Laws as so appears is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the word "cars" the following words:- or tracks and by inserting after the word
3 "commonwealth" the following new language:- Hot Box detectors shall be installed every 20
4 miles on any line in which passenger trains operate. Such shall be included in any new
5 construction project and within one year of the passage of said law on all existing lines.
