By Mr. DiDomenico, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2230) of Sal N. DiDomenico and Michael J. Barrett for legislation relative to class 3 electric bicycles. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to class 3 electric bicycles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the definition of “Class 2 electric bicycle” the following
3 definition:-

4 "Class 3 – an electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when
5 the rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of
6 28 miles per hour;"

7 Section 1 of chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting within
8 the definition of “Department” the following definition:-

9 “Electric bicycle”, a bicycle or tricycle equipped with fully operable pedals and an
10 electric motor of 750 watts or less that meets the requirements of a class 1 electric bicycle, class
11 2 electric bicycle, or class 3 electric bicycle."

12 Chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby
13 amended by inserting in section 11B³/₄ the following:-

14 "Class 3 electric bicycles shall not be ridden on a bike path or shared-use path unless
15 permitted by the municipality, local authority or state agency having jurisdiction over that path;

16 A municipality, local authority or state agency with jurisdiction over a natural surface
17 trail designated for bicycle use made by clearing and grading the soil, after public notice and a
18 public hearing may adopt ordinances or regulations prohibiting or otherwise regulating the
19 operation of electric bicycles on such paths, including, but not limited to, the imposition of speed
20 limits."

21 Chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby
22 amended by striking in section 11B³/₄ the following:-

23 "(d) An electric bicycle shall not be operated on a trail designated for nonmotorized
24 traffic, that a municipality, local authority or state agency has jurisdiction over, if such trail has a
25 natural surface tread made by clearing and grading the soil and no surfacing materials have been
26 added; provided, however, that a municipality, local authority or state agency after public notice
27 and a public hearing may adopt ordinances or regulations permitting or otherwise regulating the
28 use of electric bicycles on such a trail within its jurisdiction, including, but not limited to, the
29 imposition of speed limits."

30 Chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby
31 amended by striking in section 11B³/₄ (b) the following:- "that electric bicycles shall not be
32 ridden or operated on sidewalks."
