An Act relative to a clean fuel standard.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Within one year of the effective date of this act, the Department of Transportation shall
- 2 promulgate regulations to develop and implement a clean fuel standard. Said clean fuel standard
- 3 shall aim to reduce the carbon intensity of transportation fuels, while accounting for the full
- 4 lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions of all fuels.
