Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "chapters 117A and 118," the following

3 words:- "veterans services benefits under Chapter 115 of the General Laws,".
