An Act to create equal access to a common application for low-income veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 18AA of Chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “chapters 117A and 118,” the following
- 3 words:- "veterans services benefits under Chapter 115 of the General Laws,".
