**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to headstones for long-serving or perished members of the Massachusetts National Guard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 115 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 9 the
2 following section:-

3 SECTION 9A. The commission of veteran’s service shall furnish upon request
4 headstones for deceased members of the Massachusetts National Guard who served 10 years or
5 more or for those who have perished while performing their duties while in service of the
6 Massachusetts National Guard. Such headstones shall be similar to those furnished by the U.S.
7 Department of Veterans Affairs.
