An Act to establish the Massachusetts National Guard Museum in Salem.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting, after section 139, the following section:-

3 Section 140. There shall be a permanent museum for the Massachusetts National Guard  
4 located in the City of Salem as the federal birthplace of the National Guard. Furthermore, it shall  
5 be recognized as the official military museum for the commonwealth of Massachusetts.
